## Entering 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer Reading List

Research has shown that the single greatest factor in predicting reading success is whether a child is read to when young. Here are some titles to get you started! **Please note** that the reading level of the books suggested varies. If your child is already reading have him or her read a page of the book aloud to you to see if it is a good fit. If they struggle with more than a few words on the page, it is probably too difficult, but the book would still be a great book to read aloud to your child. **The Summer Book Report Project, that is due on Monday, August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019, is on the back.**

**Fiction titles are in order of increasing difficulty. Students are ONLY REQUIRED to READ 1 Fiction title and 1 Non-Fiction title for a total of 2 REQUIRED READS.**
